We have two key focus areas for this Newsletter including:

1. Transition from the White tape (legacy) Bridle to the Bridle Pro Range



This change forms part of a wider initiative to consolidate the number of SKUs available within the UK market, while ensuring improved continuity of supply.


The **AMT Bridle Pro** offers several key advantages:

- It is a superior product, featuring self-lubricating monofilament tubing designed to reduce adherence.
- It is evidence-based and is the only paediatric bridle system cleared by the FDA specifically for paediatric use.
- It is available in sizes 8Fr–16Fr, as well as bridles designed to accommodate a range of NG tube sizes (e.g., 4-420810, 4-421012, 4-421214). This flexibility may help reduce the need for extensive inventory within acute care settings.

2. Capsule Monarch G-Tubes



The Capsule Monarch G-Tube features a non-balloon internal bolster that is packaged within a dissolvable capsule, designed to simplify and ease the insertion process.



The **adjustable bolster** accommodates a range of stoma lengths and features stabiliser feet to promote airflow and enhance comfort.

Although the Monarch G-Tube is currently licensed for gastric placement, its use in jejunostomy feeding is increasing in clinical practice. A growing number of posters and abstracts now document outcomes in this setting, reflecting emerging interest and experience.

As an organisation, we are closely monitoring the evolving evidence base and regulatory landscape. We remain committed to evaluating all available data and are actively exploring potential options and opportunities to ensure safe, effective, and compliant use aligned with patient and clinical needs.
